HOMEOWNER'S AFFIDAVIT

I hereby certify the mechanical work described on this application shall be installed by myself in my own single-family dwelling in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Mechanical Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the Mechanical Inspector. I will cooperate with the City Mechanical Inspector, and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, being Section 123.1523a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this State relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of Section 23a are subject to civil fines.
