

FENCES

Fences: May be 6' high on side and rear yard, 3' high in front, if made of material which may obstruct vision or 4' high if open weave or chain link. If fence is along a driveway or alley that intersects a street, the fence may only be 3' high for 20' in any direction from the right of way. (Front yard is from the front side of main building toward street, side yard is along sides of building, rear yard is behind furthest projection of main building). Wire fences may be chain link with appropriate posts and rails. Wood fence must have finished side (good side) facing exterior of lot. Special Note: Fence has to be set back 25' from front property line before fence can be 6' high.

GOOD SIDE OF FENCE FACES OUT TOWARDS NEIGHBORS.

Prohibited Fences: Except for the provisions in city code, fences, walls or structural screens may not contain barbed wire, electric current, or charges of electricity.
