SUBJECT: Curwood Book Inventory

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends reviewing inventory levels for the Castle's Curwood book collection.

BACKGROUND:

The Castle's special collection of Curwood books (those not for sale) is considerably large while the gift shop copies have dwindled. The Castle Docent has suggested reviewing the special collection inventory and moving some into the gift shop. She has provided an inventory and suggestions for how many to keep of each book. For example, there are 15 copies of Green Timber in the special collection and none in the gift shop. It is suggested the Commission move 10 into the gift shop.

There are some books that are considered rare, staff is suggesting the Commission keep at least 7 of these and offer the others as part of the silent auction at the annual Christmas party with a minimum bid.

FISCAL IMPACTS:

Reviewing the inventory and moving some books into the gift shop will increase gift shop sales while still keeping at least five of each book in the special collection.
