

**City of Owosso's  
Brush Pickup for April 2013**

Brush pickup for the month of April will be on Wednesday, April 24, 2013. Please call 725-0550, or email [marlene.jungnitsch@ci.owosso.mi.us](mailto:marlene.jungnitsch@ci.owosso.mi.us), by **noon on Tuesday, April 23, 2013** to schedule your pickup. If we cannot get to everyone on the scheduled day, pickup will resume on Thursday and Friday, if necessary.

Brush collection rules:

- Brush must be out to the curb by 7:00 a.m. on pickup day. No brush piles are to be placed at curb before Monday of pickup week. Tickets may be issued for brush on parkways earlier.
- Brush must be no larger than 3" in diameter and no longer than 8' long.
- All roots, stumps and dirt must be removed from tree trunks.
- Place brush with the biggest cut end toward the curb – neatly stacked and away from trees, sign posts, guide wires, fire hydrants and fences.
- Do not place brush on sidewalks or in the street.
- Do not place brush in alleys – it will not be picked up. Tickets may be issued.
- If you do not call to be placed on the pickup list by the deadline, your brush will not be picked up.

The following material will not be collected:

- Brush cut or trimmed by tree services, lawn care services or other contractors. Persons hired by the property owners are responsible for removing materials.
- Material cleared from lots or undeveloped property.
- Material in boxes, bags or containers.
- Yard waste and grass clippings.

The Department of Public Works yard on Aiken Road, just south of Industrial Drive, is open from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. every Saturday for leaf and brush drop off.
