## 2024 Storm Sewer Televising Project Questions

- Q: Will there be any cost for water (hydrant) for the Cleaner Truck?
- A: The contractor shall supply their own water for the work. Hydrant meters are available at Owosso DPW. \$1,000 prepayment is required. This covers usage of the water meter/RPZ and bulk water prepayment per the following charges: bulk water rate is \$12 per 1,000 gallons with a \$60 minimum charge which includes the first 5,000 gallons. When water meter and RPZ are returned in good condition, \$450 will be returned less any water use over the minimum charge for 5,000 gallons.
- Q: Is there a disposal facility for the debris collected?
- A: The contractor shall be responsible for disposal of debris. The city does not have an available dump site.
- Q: Is the scope of the project to clean all debris from pipe or to be able to get the camera through and still have a quality video?
- A: Pipe shall be cleaned to ensure a complete clear video inspection meeting PACP standards.
- Q: Are easement machines allowed for areas not assessable for the Cleaner?
- A: Yes, easement machines are allowed.
- Q: Have all the manholes been located and exposed?
- A: A few manholes are believed to be buried as noted on the maps.
- Q: Due to potential interruptions and difficulty getting trucks to manholes along with bad road conditions because of winter weather can the project start date be sooner?
- A: The project can begin after contracts are signed and a notice to proceed is issued. It usually takes about 30 days after bids are received for contracts to be signed.
- Q: Can the city assist with locating and exposing any of the buried manholes?
- A: For Clyde Street: We are hoping that the camera can enter STM-2105, travel east, and find STM-2092. Once the measurement is obtained, Owosso DPW will excavate the street and raise the manhole lid to grade.

For all other streets: The city of Owosso vac truck operator can assist with finding manholes.

- Q: Is a bid bond required for this project?
- A; No, a bid bond is not required.
