2024 Sewer Lining Project Questions

- Q: Please confirm all lights and receptacles are 120volt.
- A: Lights are 240 volt and receptacles are 120 volt.
- Q: Why is 2kV cable called out on the drawings and pay items if all power systems are 120/240 volt? 2kV is not needed for this voltage.
- A: 2kV cables meets the Michigan Department of Transportation requirements for street lighting.
- Q: Notes call out to connect existing receptable wiring, can you provide a detail for this installation?
- A: Existing receptable wiring shall be spliced shall be spliced to proposed wiring within handholes or light fixtures utilizing a splice junction box or similar.
- Q: Will in-line fusing be required at each light pole for the light and receptacles?
- A: Yes
- Q: Is there a pay item to remove and reinstall brick pavers?
- A: The pay item Sidewalk, Rem, Modified covers the removal of brick pavers. Decorative concrete will replace brick pavers where shown on the plans paid for as Sidewalk, Conc, Decorative, __ inch.
- Q: Can you provide a detail for Serv Disconnect and meters? Is a Unistrut rack to support this power equipment acceptable?
- A: The contractor shall be responsible for configuring all electric equipment at each meter location. Unistrut rack is acceptable as long as it is rated for exterior use (galvanized or stainless steel)
