All work shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code</li> <li>3. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected</li> <li>4. Applicant certifies that all information given is correct</li> <li>5. Applicant shall be responsible for the scheduling of inspections</li> <li>6. HOMEOWNER – I hereby certify the electrical work described on this application shall be installed by myself in my own single-family dwelling in which I am living or about to occupy</li> <li>7. Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid 6 months after such time the permit is closed if no inspections are performed. Closed permits cannot be refunded and the charge to re-open is \$75.</li> <li>8.
