- 5. Applicant shall be responsible for the scheduling of inspections
- 6. HOMEOWNER I hereby certify the mechanical work described on this application shall be installed by myself in my own single-family dwelling in which I am living or about to occupy
- 7. Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid 6 months after such time the permit is closed if no inspections are performed. Closed permits cannot be refunded and the charge to re-open is \$75.
- 8. Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.
