RE: Skate Park

I emailed the new designs and cost estimates to the Commission members, and they are included in this packet. The new design and concept is for the new proposed location at Grove-Holman Park with a cost estimate of \$250,000. I personally am very happy with the concept considering the cost was decreased by \$100,000. Chairman Espich asked me to look at what we can do to lower the cost with in-kind donations and I will continue to do so as we move through this process.

I anticipate a long timeline for completion on this project and want to prepare Commission members what to expect. First, the master plan needs to be updated; a 5-year plan is required for DNR grants. If we except to apply for funding through the DNR in April of 2017 this update should be completed and adopted by City Council in January. Secondly, the DNR accepts grant applications for the Land and Water Fund in April with final approval in September of that year. We would request the maximum funding limit, which is \$150,000. I will know more about this process as the Curwood Castle application moves along. Thirdly, once the Land and Water Fund (LWF) application is accepted then we can propose the project for a Patronicity grant. The Patronicity grant is limited to \$100,000 with 50% crowdfunded, or donated, and the other 50% is matched by the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC). I will also get verification that the LWF needs to be committed prior to the Patronicity grant. This would bring us to the \$250,000 goal along with the approximately \$23,000 raised by the community.

If the LWF grant is awarded in the fall of 2017 and the Patronicity grant is to follow I would anticipate construction at the earliest in the spring of 2018.






