#### **ITEM OF BUSINESS**:

#### **Draft Parks and Recreation Master Plan Public Hearing:**

Chairman Workman called for public comments on the plan:

Dennis Mahoney, Owosso resident, suggested recognizing the Owosso Soccer Club on pages 13, 14, and 54 of the plan for their work in providing soccer opportunites in Owosso and their help with Hugh Parker Fields. Mr. Mahoney also commented that the draft was good and concise.

COMMISSIONER RODMAN MADE A MOTION TO MAKE THE SUGGESTED CHANGES. MOTION SUPPORTED BY COMMISSIONER SMITH. AYES ALL. MOTION CARRIED.

Commissioner Rodman suggested reviewing the letter from the Friends of the Shiawassee River. Discussion about the Shi-Tri followed. COMMISSIONER RODMAN MADE A MOTION TO ADD THE SHI-TRI TO THE COMMUNITY EVENT SECTION OF THE PLAN. MOTION SUPPORTED BY COMMISSIONER BILA. AYES ALL. MOTION CARRIED.

The Commission discussed the Friends of the Shiawassee River's requests to add an action item for controlling invasive species along the river and removing or modifying the three low head dams within the city limits. Commissioner Bila requested more information on invasive species versus native species and stated he was not in favor of removing the dams. Commissioner Rodman stated she needed more information than was provided before making a decision on the dams. COMMISSIONER HORTON MADE A MOTION TO TABLE

THE DISCUSSION ON THE LOW HEAD DAMS AND THE INVASIVE SPECIES. MOTION SUPPORTED BY COMMISSIONER RODMAN. AYES ALL, MOTION CARRIED.

Commissioner Smith commented that the plan was beautiful and thanked everyone for a great job.
